THE BENEFICE OF OFFWELL, FARWAY & WIDWORTHY AUGUST & SEPTEMBER 2022

It seems a very human frailty to go on repeating the mistakes of the past, to think we have learnt the lessons after often paying a terrible price only for the next generation to prove it has forgotten them by repeating them.

War is raging on the Eastern marches of Europe because in part the West forgot the hard lessons of the 1920s and 1930s by disarming and by 'doing business' with aggressive authoritarian rulers. Now after a 14 years of digital money printing and an energy supply shock, caused at least in part by governments' being unwilling to invest in energy security, inflation has returned dramatically and the media is full of talk about a 'return to the turmoil of the 1970s. We've been here before.

In the City there is a cynical wisdom that when pundits say, 'this time it's different' and that the fundamental laws of economics no longer apply, it is time to sell and prepare for a crash or worse. Modern Monetary Theory is merely the latest of these and sadly it will be the poor, the middling sort, those living on fixed incomes without index linked pensions, and small businesses who pay the worst price.

So, if we flawed humans keep on getting swept along by the follies of the moment and repeating the same old mistakes, what is the answer? The answer surely rooting our lives in unchanging absolute truth, a truth not subject to the vagaries of fashion or popularity. One that is incorruptible, eternal, that encompasses the fundamental workings of the universe, the laws of physics and reason: something the Greeks called "logos" from which we derive our word 'logic' but the Greek conception is far bigger and wider. It's about the whole underpinning of reality that works according to laws comprehensible to human reason and what we call science and philosophy.

The famous first verse of the first chapter of the Gospel according to St John talks about the 'Word' of God but the original Greek word' is 'logos', the rational underpinning of realty, and the logos of God is Jesus Christ, the embodiment of the divine ordering of reality. For we Christians, faith in the logos of God, eternal, unchanging, incorruptible, is a rational response to rules that govern the realities of our world because Jesus embodies God's continuing purpose in creating and sustaining the Universe and, just as we must pay heed to the physical laws around us, so we must pay heed to the moral and societal laws taught by Christ. Perhaps if we do, we might no longer repeat the mistakes of the past and avoid much trouble and misery.
