THE BENEFICE OF OFFWELL, FARWAY & WIDWORTHY OCTOBER & NOVEMBER 2022

I am delighted to be writing to you as the new Priest-in-Charge for St Mary's Offwell, St Cuthbert's Widworthy, and St Michael and All Angels Farway.

It has been a staggering 5 years since there was last a serving incumbent for these beautiful parishes, and yet during that time these churches have continued to meet and serve anyway. There are many reasons for their resilience, but I would like to pay particular tribute to our churchwardens David Pavey, Jonathan Paveley, Marion Hutchinson, Tara Huffman, Robin Banks, Mary Wakeley, and Mim Prins. Ecclesiastical vacancies are not meant to be 5 years long, and churchwardenship can be challenging at the best of times.

There are three things you should expect from me. The first is prayer. Churches that pray for their communities will be better at serving their communities. That's not to say that our churches are not praying already, on the contrary, I am simply acknowledging the connection. I have seen from my own experience the transforming power of a church that has the community at its heart, and takes prayer seriously. For whatever is on our heart will inevitably speak into our prayers, and our prayers will speak into our actions.

Secondly, my work with our two Church of England primary schools. It's not meant to sound like a cliche, but I do believe children are our future. So, resourcing the connection between our churches and our two wonderful church schools will be one of my priorities, and something I will very much enjoy.

Lastly, there are some tough economic challenges ahead, in addition to the last two years we've had. I am under no illusion as to the challenges many will face, but I remain wholeheartedly committed to serving here and will do my very best to lead our churches as they continue to help those who struggle most.

The message I will keep to is simple. The Gospel of Jesus Christ is the message of love that our communities will need to hear, both in action and in word. It is the kind of love that overcomes any darkness, heals any rift, brings peace and builds up the church. It is seen best when we come together, support one another and care for one another. It is what Jesus taught his disciples to share, and it is the task of the Church today.

Ruth and I have felt enormously welcomed by the villages and are settled well at the Rectory in Offwell. We hope to see you all soon, for a pasty or a cream tea, and we must remember... cream on top, no wait... jam on top! \sim
