The additional fees to complete the payment for a 'simple wedding' (£135) should be made in the same way at least one month prior to your marriage ceremony. All other 'permitted extras' can be made on the day of your wedding by cash.

Notes:

1. Searches in church registers

The search fee relates to a particular search where the approximate date of the baptism or marriage is known. The fee for a more general search of a church register is negotiable.

2. Costs and expenses

In the case of a marriage service in church, any costs and expenses incurred in respect of routine administration (including arranging dates and times and the making of entries in registers), making the church available and lighting it are included in the fee prescribed as payable to the parochial church council.

3. CPI Increase

The 2019 Order set the framework for fees until 2024. It provided that fees would increase annually in line with CPI. The Archbishops' Council will be asked to consider if this remains appropriate in the light of prevailing inflation levels and may propose a revision to be considered by General Synod in February 2023.

5. Extras

The fees shown in the Church of England table of fees as shown on the Church of England do not include charges for heating, the services of a verger, music (e.g. organist, choir), bells, and flowers, which are fixed by the Parochial Church Council. In the case of a marriage service any costs and expenses incurred in respect of routine administration (including arranging dates and times and the making of entries in registers), making the church available and lighting it are included in the fee prescribed as payable to the Parochial Church Council.
